- All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant and his/her educational institution.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible applicants for this academic scholarship:

- Are 2010 Playing Members of the Illinois Junior Golf Association
- Have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement
- Have been accepted at an accredited institution of higher learning for the upcoming academic year (verification required).

- High School transcript
- Copy of your highest ACT scores
- Letter of recommendation from either a high school math or science teacher
- One page essay response to the following three (3) questions:
 - What are your future educational, professional and personal goals?
 - What life lessons have you learned from golf?
 - Please describe your Math and Science involvement in high school. Classes, clubs and/or special projects.
